\*Year to date, 60 households account for the 76 positive cases and the total number includes all students and staff.

Our number of positive cases remains the same as last week. We have 39 high school students in quarantine due to close contacts associated with basketball and football. As of today, both the Varsity and Jr. Varsity Boys' Basketball Seasons have come to a close. We are closely monitoring our students in quarantine and are communicating with both the Ogle and Stephenson County Health Departments.

Our regional area is seeing a decrease in transmission, overall positivity rates, and the number of new cases. The incident at the high school is solely related to our inability to social distance during basketball and football activities. However, we want to be mindful that COVID-19 is a virus. Please continue to follow all precautions and pay careful attention to your student as you complete your daily symptom screener. If your son or daughter is not feeling well, please keep them home.
