Device Purchase Options:

Students participating in BYOT are not required to use a specific device, nor does the district endorse one device or brand over another. The only requirement is the student can connect their device to the district wireless network. However, parents may purchase a device through the district, if desired, and obtain the same price point offered to the district through bulk ordering, resulting in a savings to families. Three device options are available to parents and are described in the information below.

Models will be available for demonstration on Wednesday, April 13th from 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. in the FHS Library for those interested in previewing prior to purchase.

Option 1: Dell Chromebook 11" \$220

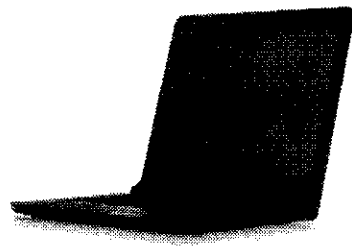

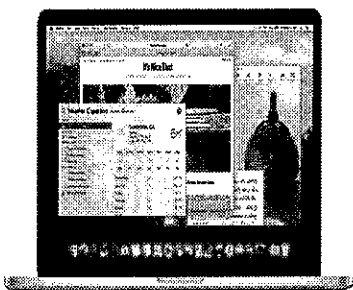
