e-Learning and Grading Q&A

Forrestville Valley School District is currently operating with remote learning during the COVID19 Stay-At-Home Order. This brings many challenges as we start to discuss grading and acquisition of high school credits. Please review the following Q&A to help assist you and your student during this time. If you have questions please contact your school office.

Q: Will my student receive grades for work they are completing remotely?

A: Yes: Teachers will assign PASS (P) or INCOMPLETE (I) grades to students during this remote learning period. This will start the week of April 6th. Parents can expect to see a minimum of one assignment per week in the Skyward System.

Q: Will these Pass/Incomplete Grades impact my students GPA?

A: No; the Illinois State Board of Education has stated this remote period should not negatively impact any student and their overall academic performance. All cumulative GPA's will be locked with the end of the 2019 1st semester until school resumes.

Q: Will my student continue to accumulate high school credits for graduation?

A: Yes; provided they are passing. A passing grade (P) will ensure credit is issued for the course your student is enrolled in. If a student receives an incomplete grade (I) during this time, he or she will not receive credit until the work is complete.

Q: How can I know my student's grades during this remote learning period?

A: Skyward System: Please use your family access account to log in and see your child's grades. Please note you will only see a Pass or Incomplete grade.

Q: What happens when school resumes?

A: Teachers will determine a final Pass (P) or Incomplete (I) grade for the duration of e-Learning. Students earning a Pass (P) will continue with no impact to the grades they received prior to and after our closure. Students who earn an Incomplete (I) must complete the required material prior to the end of the year to generate a cumulative grade. Final year calculations will only include scores before and after our closure.

Q: What if my student was planning to retake an assessment prior to the closure?

A: Please have your student contact their teacher to see if they are eligible based on specific teacher criteria.

Q: What happens if this closure extends through May?

A: If the closure is extended teachers will assign final grades of Pass (P) or Incomplete (I). While grades will not count in the overall GPA, high school credits will be issued for passing grades. Summer recovery will be necessary for those receiving an Incomplete.
