#### COMMITMENT TO EARLY CHILDHOOD OPPORTUNITIES

In coordination with the Illinois State Board of Education's "School Readiness Initiative," the Forrestville Valley School District #221 is committed to providing early learning opportunities that are preparing students who are "Ready for Success." For the 2017—2018 school year, this includes:

## 1. Expanding Kindergarten Programming

~ Forrestville Valley School District will be providing **FULL** Day Kindergarten to all district students.

## 2. Expanding Preschool Programming

- ~ Parents may choose to enroll their Preschool child in the following tuition-based Little Cardinals Preschool:
  - \* FULL Day Preschool for 2, 3, 4, or 5 days per week; or
  - \* Morning Preschool for 2, 3, 4, or 5 days per week.
- ~ For qualifying students, the P.A.S.S. Program will continue to be held.

## 3. Maintaining Elementary Attendance Centers

- ~ German Valley Grade School will house the Kindergarten and Preschool Programs.
- ~ Forreston Grade School will house 1st Grade—5th Grade Students.

## 4. Providing Additional Staffing

~ Additional staff may be hired, based on student enrollment in each program.

## 2019 — 2020 Strategic Planning Implementation

The Forrestville Valley School District strives to promote excellence in all of its students.

The district is home to not only one Exemplary Status school, but two. Both Forreston Grade School and Forreston Junior/Senior High School were named Exemplary in the Fall of 2018 by the Illinois State Board of Education. This status places our schools among the top 10% of schools in the entire state of Illinois.

### Curriculum

Curriculum continues to be an important part of the Forrestville Valley School District. To pursue excellence in curriculum content, Mrs. Garnhart is transitioning to *Curriculum Director* at the start of the 2019 – 2020 school year. This additional position will support teachers and instructional coaches with ongoing curriculum alignment and movement towards standards based grading.

## Project Lead the Way (PLTW)

PLTW is expanding and will require an additional Secondary Science Teacher to launch a new course titled, "Principles of Engineering". This is the second course in the Engineering Pathway and will follow "Introduction to Engineering Design". Students in grades 9 - 12 are welcome to explore these courses.

## Cardinal Field Complex

Through the partnership with Forreston Sports Boosters, work continues on the Cardinal Field Complex with the addition of Softball dugouts and excavation for the Baseball field. The Softball field is now near completion, and the Baseball field will be coming in 2020!

## • Staff Tuition Waiver

Forrestville Valley School District is dedicated to recruiting and sustaining high quality staff. The Illinois State Board of Education approved the district for a waiver of Section 10-20.12a of the School Code in the Fall of 2018. Beginning in the 2019 - 2020 school year, any out-of-district staff member may enroll their student(s), and the out-of-district tuition cost will be waived.

## Skyward and Skylert
