Reading and Phonics are a major focus in second grade. Your child will have reading homework twice a week. There will be a reading log to sign on Tuesday and Thursday. Be sure to read with your child daily. Some students may be working with Ms. Kenney or Mrs. Braker for extra help. If you have questions about reading, don't hesitate to ask.

Spelling homework will be on Monday nights. Much of our phonics instruction focuses on writing the sounds you hear and then transfers into more correct spellings as we learn and practice new phonetic patterns each week.

Math is another major focus in second grade. Math homework will be on Wednesday nights. This is usually a reinforcement of the skills we are working on in class or practicing math fact flashcards. It is not graded.
