Please see our COVID-19 data from this week below:

No close contacts were identified this week and school transmission continues to remain LOW. However, 11 close contacts were identified and quarantined due to a large gathering outside of school hours. Please do your part to minimize gatherings of students to keep our students in school.

Year to date, 34 households account for the 46 positive cases.

In addition to Coronavirus, we continue to monitor for other student or staff illness. This week we were informed of a case of pertussis, commonly known as whooping cough. This was an isolated incident, which did not require any further intervention from the school community.

As a reminder, if you will be gathering during the holiday break please follow the quarantine recommendations and change your student to remote learning. This option is available for all students for any number of days through January 19th.

If you wish to make a more permanent change to your child's learning environment, the window opens next week to request changes for third quarter. Please contact your building office PRIOR to the start of winter break. Students will transition to the selected learning environment on January 4, 2021 and continue this selection through the end of 3rd quarter, Friday, March 5th.
