For those with advanced plans we would ask for you to communicate your remote learning dates prior to leaving for either the Thanksgiving or Christmas holiday break.

Decisions regarding school operations and COVID-19 continue to evolve on a daily basis. Should remote learning become necessary due to a change in data or state order we will notify you via the Skylert and Skyward systems.
