*Year to date, 52 households account for the 65 positive cases and the total number includes all students and staff.

We are happy to report our school transmission continues to remain LOW.

This week we identified 20 students due to close contact as a precautionary measure; 18 students were identified as close contacts due to transportation while two students were identified due to participation in educational programs outside the district. We continue to have zero close contacts identified in our classroom settings.

We are also happy to report our region has returned to Tier 1, which will allow for after school activities to resume within specific parameters outlined by the Illinois All Sports Policy.

More information will be coming home from FJSHS regarding schedules to resume such activities in the very near future. In addition, we are excited to announce we are adding flexibility for our junior high students. Starting Monday, January 25th, when classroom space allows, junior high students will be able to move locations throughout their block schedules while remaining in their assigned cohorts. All safety measures will remain in place during these transitions.
