Allocation: \$829,565


Use of Funds:

- Coordinate responses to prevent, prepare for, and respond to COVID-19
- Resources to address the needs of individual schools
- Conduct activities to address unique needs of low-income & students with disabilities
- Purchase supplies to sanitize & clean facilities
- Provide technology for remote learning
- Provide mental health services & supports
- Implement summer learning & after-school programs
- Address impact of lost instructional time due to COVID-19 pandemic
- Upgrade facilities to include heating, ventilation, and air conditioning systems
